We would like to inform you that we have recently become aware of cases of head lice in our FS2 class. While head lice are common among young children and not harmful, we kindly ask for your support in checking your child's hair and treating any head lice promptly to help prevent further spread.

To check for head lice:

- Use a fine-toothed comb on damp hair to detect any lice or eggs.
- Pay special attention to the back of the neck and behind the ears.

If lice are found, please follow the recommended treatment:

- Over-the-counter treatments are available at pharmacies.
- Wet combing with conditioner can also be an effective method.

Regular checks and prompt treatment are key in keeping head lice under control.
