Learning Journey

- This half term FS2 will be reading three traditional tales: Jack and the Beanstalk, The Little Red Hen and The Enormous Turnip. We will explore the setting and characters of the stories and have a go at writing simple versions of them.
- In Maths we will be focusing on sharing and grouping, patterns, position, direction and mapping.
- Rhyme time focus: Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush and The Grand Old Duke of York (movement rhymes).
- Children will learn about the artist David Hockney, who paints landscapes using bright colours. We will be creating our own landscape art in this style as backgrounds for our core text stories.
- We will celebrate the end of our topic by having a teddy bear's picnic with our families!
