- Log onto Spelling shed and practice weekly spellings.

- Log onto TT rockstars and battle against your friends or perhaps complete a soundcheck.

Reminders

- **Our PE days are Monday and Friday so we ask that children could bring PE kit to change into on these days.**

Learning journey – Why did the Anglo-Saxons settle in Britain?

English – In English, we will be reading Beowulf which links to our Anglo-Saxon topic. We will be writing a persuasive speech and a narrative.

Maths – We will be following the White rose scheme of work covering the following units: place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.

Science – We will be looking at materials and their properties as part of our chemistry unit.

History – We will be researching the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We will be exploring who they were, where they came from as well as the changes they made to civilisation

Art – We will be researching jewellery worn by the Anglo-Saxons, then designing and creating our own.

Spanish – In Spanish we will be learning to recall numbers to 100, say when our birthdays are and where we live.

PSHE – This half term we are focusing on how to create a caring school and how to maintain healthy relationships.

Computing – We will be looking at internet safety, systems and networking.


RE – We will be researching different sacred books.
