Practise times tables (up to 12 x 12) using TT Rockstars. This will help with all our maths learning.



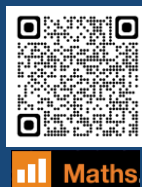
Practise your spellings at home. These will be tested every Monday (not those on zappers). You can also log on to spelling shed at home.

## Learning Journey

**English** – We will continue reading Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman then read a children's version of Macbeth. We will be writing complaint letters, non-chronological reports and poetry.

**Maths** – We will be covering units about fractions. We will cover how to add, subtract, multiply and divide with fractions, find fractions of an amount and convert fractions. We will also learn about decimals.

**Science** – This half term we are learning about living things and their habitats focusing on micro-organisms and classification.

**History** – We will be learning about the ancient civilisation of Maya, answering the question 'Were Ancient Maya great builders?'.

**Computing** – The focus during computing sessions this term is 3D modelling using 'Tinkercad'.

**Art** – Our project this half term is drawing and painting linked to Ancient Maya.

**PSHE** - Our unit is 'The Caring School and Growing Up – Relationships'.

**Music** – We will be looking at dynamics, pitch and tempo.

**Spanish** - The topic this half term is 'La comida – food'.

**PE** – We will cover dance and have a unit called 'Joy of Movement' being taught by RUFC.
