Learning Journey

English – In reading sessions, we will be reading Letters from the Lighthouse. In writing sessions, we will cover persuasive letters and motivational speeches.

Maths – We will finish our unit about decimals and then study fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also cover area, perimeter and volume and algebra.

Science – In science, we are looking at light and carrying out experiments to discover that light travels in straight lines, how the eye works and how shadows are formed.

History – We will be answering the question ‘How did war affect people?’

Computing – This half term the children will be learning how to use excel spreadsheets. We will also look at the use of formulas.

Art – We will be using Henry Moore as inspiration and creating charcoal drawings linked to his shelter drawings.

PSHE - Our unit is Growing Up and Responsibilities.

Spanish - The topic this half term is ‘Mi Pueblo – my town’.

RE – We will be answering the question ‘Who is inspiring?’
