## Learning Journey – Why did the Vikings come to settle in Britain?

**English** – In English, we will be writing a balanced argument discussing whether Vikings deserve the reputation that they have today. We will also be writing a persuasive letter based on pollution and climate change. We will also be reading the text 'Holes'.

**Maths** – We will be following the Whiterose scheme of work covering the following units: multiplication and division & fractions.

**Science** – We will continue exploring our 'Properties of materials' unit.

**Design & Technology** – We will be looking at how Vikings travelled and designing and creating our very own Viking longboat.

**History** – We will be researching the who the Vikings were and where they came from.

**Spanish** – We will be learning to order different foods and drinks from a restaurant.
