Reading - please encourage your child to read at least three times a week and sign their planner to show that they are reading regularly. Planners are checked every Monday. Raffle tickets awarded for children reading 3 times a week!

Spellings – your child will bring their spelling list home every Monday. Spelling patterns can be practised on Spelling Shed. They will be tested on their words the following Monday.

Maths - Practise times tables (up to 12 x 12) using TT Rockstars. Please encourage your child to go on Maths Frame too, there are lots of fun maths games to have a go at!

Topic ideas:

- Create a poem all about stopping pollution
- Could you be creative and use items from home to create a new product.
- Find ways at home to reduce plastic waste at home.
- Create an information text about plastic pollution, you might include the problems, ways to improve etc.

Learning Journey

English - In English we will be finishing reading 'The boy at the back of the class' and then we will be reading 'Why the Whale Came'. In writing we will be focusing on writing a non-chronological report, persuasion and poetry.

Maths – In maths we will be completing work on the following topics: addition and subtraction, area and multiplication and division.

Science – In science lessons, we will be completing our states of matter unit before moving on to living things and their habitats.

Geography - In Geography, we will be learning about European countries and where they are located, identifying the significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern and Southern hemisphere, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and the Arctic and Antarctic Circle. We will also look at human and physical geography of European countries.

Computing - In computing, we will be completing a unit on audio editing and creating a podcast.

DT – In DT our focus will be completing a project on mechanisms/

PSHE – In PSHE, we will carry on our topic on feelings, friends and friendships then we will move on to the unit - respecting the differences between people.

PE - During our PE lessons this half term, we will be doing dance and gymnastics.

Spanish – In Spanish, we will be completing a unit on birthdays – days, months and saying the date.

Music – In music, we will be continuing our unit on changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics.

RE – We will be looking at Christian and Hindu answers to a range of questions.
