Reading - please encourage your child to read at least three times a week and sign their planner to show that they are reading regularly. Planners are checked every Monday.

Spellings – your child will bring their spelling list home every Monday. Spelling patterns can be practised on Spelling Shed. They will be tested on their words each week.

Maths - Practise times tables (up to 12 x 12) using TT Rockstars. Please encourage your child to go on Maths Frame too, there are lots of fun maths games to have a go at!

Topic ideas

- Create a PowerPoint about natural disasters to share with the rest of the class.
- Create a volcano using papier Mache.
- Produce some artwork focusing on a particular natural disaster.
- Create a poster about how to stay safe during an earthquake.

Learning Journey

English – We will be finishing reading 'Why the Whales Came' and then we will be reading 'Into the Volcano' by Jess Butterworth and 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. During our writing lessons we will be writing a setting description, non-chronological report and dialogue.

Maths – In maths we will be completing work on the following topics: multiplication and division, length and perimeter and fractions.

Science – our topic is living things and their habitats.

Geography – In our geography lessons we will learn about the structure of earth before learning what causes earthquakes, tsunamis, eruptions. We will also look at how natural disasters changed the way countries now look.

Computing - In computing, we will be focusing on the topic: photo editing and creating digital posters

D & T - we will be designing and creating moving monsters using levers and linkages

Art – we will look at work by the artist David Hockney and create our own photomontage.

PSHE – we will be completing the unit 'respecting the differences between people and ways to keep ourselves safe

PE – During our PE lessons this half term, we will be doing sports hall athletics and hockey

Spanish – we will be learning about shapes and colours and a Spanish Artist – Miro

Music – we will be completing a unit focused on body and tuned percussion.
