Learning Journey

English – We will be looking at the features of and writing a fact file report about different skeletons and a diary entry about a discovery in ancient Egypt. In reading, we will be studying the book 'Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo and continuing our daily fluency work.

Maths – We will be looking at multiplication, fractions and mass and capacity.

Science – We will be covering animals including humans and looking into what our muscles do, whether animals all have the same skeleton and what types of nutrition we need.

History – We will be studying ancient Egypt including the chronology and delving into why we know so much about Tutankhamun.

Art- We will be creating an Ancient Egyptian Mask using sculpture.

Computing- In computing we will be creating our own interactive comics linked to ancient Egypt.

PSHE- In PSHE we will be looking at choices, emotions, differences and the importance of treating everyone the same.

RE- We will be learning about Hindu gods and how Hindu's worship.

PE- We will be doing hockey and sports hall athletics.

Spanish- We will be learning about pencil case items and school.
