Learning Journey

- Nursery are learning about Nocturnal Animals this half term and traditional tales set in the woodlands.
- The core texts we will be reading are Pumpkin Soup, The Very Helpful Hedgehog, The Leaf Thief, Goldilocks and the three bears and Little Red Riding Hood.
- In Maths we will be beginning to order number names, subitising to 3, joining in with repeating patterns and exploring position and space.
- We will find out about the artist Eric Carle and create our own woodland animal masks using Carle's techniques.
- We will also be observing and talking about the changes we notice in the woodland area
