Learning Journey

- We are learning about 'People Who Help Us' this half term. Our topic is called 'To the Rescue!' We will be focusing on the police, firefighters, dentists, doctors and nurses, vets and postal workers.
- Some of the core texts we will be reading are Busy people - police officer, Emergency, Mog and the Vet and The night before the dentist.
- In Maths we will be exploring numbers 1, 2 and 3. We will be focusing on counting objects and subitising amounts. We will also be exploring position and routes using the following positional language: under, over, through and between.
- We will find out about the artist Jackson Pollock and create our own pictures using marbles to print and mix colours. We will also explore how to mix secondary colours using primary colours.
