Year 5 National Mining Museum Trip

On Wednesday 08 July 2026 our Year 5 children will visit the National Mining Museum. The class will take a trip underground where they will meet and speak to a real-life miner in a real mine, allowing them to see what the life of a miner was like. The class will also explore the museum.

We will be leaving school at approximately 09:00 and will return to school at approximately 14:45pm.

The cost of the experience is £20.50 per pupil. Payment contributions will go towards the cost of the workshop and coach travel. Payments should be made via ParentPay. The deadline for payments is 02 July 2026. If you have any difficulties accessing your ParentPay account, please contact the school office who will be happy to assist you. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact the school office to discuss payment plan options.

Your child will need to wear school uniform as normal. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals a packed lunch can be ordered from the kitchen. Please let the office know.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
