Homework Menu

- Go for a walk with a grown up and look out for signs of Spring. Can you spot any flowers growing? What is the weather like? You could take a photo or draw a picture of what you see.
- Make a weather chart to show what the weather is like each day.
- Lots of baby animals are born in Spring. Use the internet or a book to help you find out what these baby animals are called: sheep, pig, duck, cow and chicken.
- Don't forget to share your library and phonics books with your family. Please record this each time in your reading record. You must read 3 times to earn a house point. You can also record other books you read at home too!

Learning Journey

- Reception will be learning about the four seasons and what happens in Spring. We will focus on the life cycle of plants and trees and find out about baby animals born in Spring.
- They will be reading lots of non-fiction books about the seasons as well as the core texts: A Year With Kipper, When Will it be Spring?, Erroll's Garden, The Extraordinary Gardner and Emma's Lamb.
- In Maths children will be comparing numbers and finding bonds to 10. We will also explore 3D shapes and patterns.
- Rhyme time focus: Incy Wincy Spider and The Animal Fair (action rhymes).
- Children will learn about the artist Andy Goldsworthy and create natural art in our woodland area inspired by his work.
- We will celebrate the end of our topic by going on a walk to the woods in Ravenfield! Children will hunt for signs of Spring along the way.
