## Learning Journey

**English** – In reading sessions, we will finish Letters from the Lighthouse. In writing sessions, we will cover biographies and non-chronological reports.

**Maths** – We will finish our unit about algebra and then move on to look at ratio. We will also learn about angles.

**Science** – In science, we are looking at Evolution and Inheritance linking to Charles Darwin.

**Computing** – This half term the children will be learning how to control variables in games.

**Art** – This will be sculpture inspired by Barbara Hepworth.

**PSHE** – Our unit this half term is Money Management and Careers.

**Spanish** – The children will focus on 'El día de los libros y la lectura – World Book Day and reading'. "Book Fiesta" (Bilingual Mexican book)
