Homework Menu

Your child should read their **Phonics** reading book at home at least three times a week. This book will be sent home **every Friday** and is one that the children will have been practising in their lessons throughout the week.

You will also receive a link every **Friday at 3pm** to the Ruth Miskin website, where your child can practise their Speed Sounds.

For **Maths**, there are a range of online resources such as Top Marks, where your child can play fun and engaging maths games. This term, we are focusing on:

- Place Value within 50
- Length and Height



Learning Journey

English- This term, the children will begin by writing a description, focusing on describing a character, a setting and an object. Towards the end of the term, we will then move on to writing instructions.

Maths- In Maths, we will be covering key units including Place Value within 50, as well as measurements such as: Length and Height. Children will develop their understanding through practical activities and problem-solving.

Science- In Science we will continue our focus on Plants. Children will explore how a variety of different plants change over time and will learn how to plant a seed.

We will also be learning about the season of spring and discussing what happens to the weather at this time of year.
