## Learning Journey

**English** - In English we will be continue reading 'Into the Volcano' by Jess Butterworth and 'Escape to Pompeii' by Christina Balit. During our writing lessons we will be writing poetry, diary and dialogue.

**Maths** – In maths we will be completing work on the following topics: length and perimeter and fractions.

**Science** – We will be finishing our topic on living things and their habitats before moving on to our unit on sound.

**History** - In History, we will be continuing to learn about the Romans. We will explore Hadrian's wall and what life was like there for soldiers, what Romans did in their spare time and to investigate the Romans in Rotherham.

**Geography** – In our geography lessons we will be finishing our unit on natural disasters.

**Computing** - In computing, we will be focusing on the topic: microbits

**Art** – We will be looking at the artist Steven Wiltshire and creating our own cityscapes.

**RE** - In RE, we will be completing the unit around worship, pilgrimage and community in relation to Christianity and Hinduism.

**PSHE** – In PSHE we will be finishing our unit on respecting the differences between people before moving on to the unit – keeping ourselves safe.

**PE** – During our PE lessons this half term, we will be doing cricket and tag rugby.

**Spanish** – In Spanish, we will be learning about parts of the body, describing hair and faces.
