Learning Journey

English – In English, we will be reading The True Story Of The Three Little Pigs by Jon Scieszka and The Lost Happy Endings by Caroline Duffy. We will be writing a narrative for an alternative fairy tale and a persuasive letter to the fairy tale king.

Maths – In maths, we will focus on multiplication of division of two-digit numbers by a 1-digit number. We will also be looking at length and perimeter.

Science – In science the children will be looking at light and shadows by carrying out investigations.

Geography – In geography we will be doing a local area study including looking at both human and physical features.

Art- In art we will be studying George Seurat and looking in to pointillism to create a fairy tale scenery.

Computing- In computing we will be learning how to create a branching database.

PSHE- In PSHE we will be looking at keeping ourselves safe.

PE- In PE we will be doing cricket and tag rugby.

Spanish- In Spanish the children will be learning questions, numbers and colours.

Music- In music we will be learning singing techniques.
