Learning Journey

- During this half term, we are learning about farms and discovering what animals live there.
- The core texts we will be reading are: The Farmyard Hullabaloo and Farmer Duck.
- In Maths we will be subitising to 3, comparing and sorting objects and learning about repeats.
- This half term we are getting chicks! On Tuesday 21st April the eggs will be arriving. Nursery will be observing the changes that happen throughout the life cycle of a chick.
