## Learning Journey

**English** – In reading sessions, we will be practising our comprehension skills in preparation for SATs. In writing sessions, we will cover persuasive adverts linking to South America and balanced arguments.

**Maths** – We will finish our unit about area, perimeter and volume. We will then revise different aspects of the KS2 maths curriculum.

**RE** – Our learning will answer the question 'What will make our community respectful?'

**Geography** – We will look at the continent of South America and its human and physical features and trade opportunities. We will focus in on Brazil looking at the Amazon rainforest and deforestation.

**Computing** – This half term the children will be creating their own web page.

**DT** – Our project this half term is designing and creating a frame structure.

**PSHE** – Our unit is 'Emotions and Transition to Secondary School'.

**Spanish** – The children will learn about the Spanish speaking world – typical Spanish names and Spanish speaking countries.

**Music** – We will be looking at Baroque.

**PE** – We will be learning the skills for athletics and OAA in our 2 sessions per week.
