Year 6 Human Circulatory Workshop

On Wednesday 7 October 2026 we have arranged for Year 6 to take part in a fun and engaging workshop linked to their science topic. Pops will be in school to deliver an interactive outdoor learning workshop about how the circulatory system works. It will cover how blood is transported throughout the body, voluntary and involuntary actions and how the human heart works. The class will create a huge human heart with signs to mark each functioning element e.g. Ventricles, atriums Aorta etc. They will become a blood cell and follow the journey through the body from oxygenated blood to deoxygenated blood passing through all major organs along the way.

Your child will need to wear school uniform as normal. The workshop will start at 9:30am and finish before lunchtime. Your child can have their usual meal arrangements on the day.

The cost of the experience is £6.50 per pupil. Payment contributions will go towards the cost of the workshop. Payments should be made via MCAS. The deadline for payment is 02 October 2026. If you have any difficulties accessing your MCAS account, please contact the school office who will be happy to assist you. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact the school office to discuss payment plan options.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
