Learning Journey

English – In English we will be writing a narrative, a persuasive letter. We will be reading I was born in the Stone Age by Michael Rosen and Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Ktamura.

Maths – In maths, we will be focusing on place value and addition and subtraction.

Science – This half term we will be looking at rocks. We will be comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks based on their appearance and physical properties, learning about how some rocks are formed, learning about the different layers of the earth and describing how fossils are formed.

History – In history, we will learn about the history of the Stone Age, we will explore what life was like during this period, where the Stone Age fits within history and why this period came to an end.

Art - In art, we will be focusing on the artist Alice Seaborn and using her influence to create our own cave paintings.

Computing - We are exploring computer networks and learning how devices such as laptops connect and communicate with each other.

PSHE - This term in PSHE we will be learning about being a caring school (feelings, friends and relationships).

RE - In RE we will be learning about Christianity and exploring the question 'Why do some people think Jesus is inspirational?'

PE - This half term we will be doing Fundamentals and Golf.

Spanish - In Spanish, we will be learning greetings, colours and numbers to ten.
