Learning Journey

English – We will be reading 'The boy at the back of the class' and Greek myths. In writing we will be writing a narrative and a diary entry which will link to our Ancient Greek topic.

Maths – We will be following the White Rose scheme of work covering the following units: Place value and addition & subtraction.

Science – We will be focusing on States of matter.' In this topic, we will explore solids, liquids and gases, how some materials change state when they are heated or cooled and the parts played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

History – We will be studying Greek life, their culture and how significant the Olympics were.

Computing – We will be completing a unit about understanding the internet.

Art – We will be exploring how artists use sculpture to show the significance of individuals.

PSHE – We will explore families and relationships, focusing on what healthy & unhealthy relationships look like.

RE – We will explore Christian and Hindu beliefs about God.

PE – We will focus on basketball and fitness.

Spanish – We will complete a unit all about presenting ourselves.

Music – In music, we will be learning about composition and notation; our theme is Rivers.



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
