Learning Journey

English – In English, we will be reading Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo. We will write a persuasive speech linked to an Anglo-Saxon battle and a narrative.

Maths – In maths, we will focus on Place value, addition and subtraction and begin multiplication and division.

Science – In science the children will be looking at materials and their properties as part of our chemistry unit.

History – In history we will be researching the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We will be exploring who they were, where they came from as well as the changes they made to civilisation.

Art- In art we will be studying drawing and creating our own Celtic art.

Computing- In computing we will be looking at search engines.

PSHE- In PSHE we will be looking at creating a caring school and learn how to maintain healthy relationships.

PE- In PE we will be doing volleyball and golf.

Spanish- In Spanish the children will be learning about school subjects.

RE- In RE we will understand what we can learn from stories from the bible.
