You should read at least 3 times a week. Make sure you write it in your planner and hand it in on a Friday so you can be awarded house points.

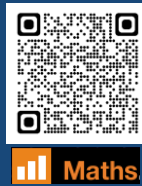
Practise times tables (up to 12 x 12) using TT Rockstars. This will help with all our maths learning.

Learning Journey

English – We will be reading a few short books this half term including *Sleeper* and *the Spindle*, *Rain Player* and *Macbeth*. We will be writing character descriptions, complaint letters and a short narrative.

Maths – We will be covering units about place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and converting units of measurement.

Science – We are looking at 'The Circulatory System'. This links to our PSHE work.

History – We will be answering the question 'Were Ancient Maya great builders?'

Computing – The focus during computing sessions this half term is computing systems and networks.

Art – We will create sculptures based on Yayoi Kusama.

PSHE – Our unit is 'The World of Drugs and Staying Safe Online'.

RE – This term the children will be learning about Christian Aid and Islamic Relief charities.

Spanish – In Spanish lessons, the children will cover 'Bienvenido a la clase española – Why learn Spanish'.

PE – We will cover volleyball and golf.

Music - Dynamics, pitch and texture – Coast is our unit this half term.



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
