

Writing

We will write a postcard from a fairy tale character in prison, a newspaper report about a fairy tale crime, a retelling of the legend of Robin Hood and a piece of descriptive poetry.

Spelling, punctuation and grammar will be linked with each of the different genres.

Maths

During the first half term we will be learning about place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will also be working on our arithmetic skills daily.

Computing

The focus during computing sessions is e-safety. We will be creating a guide to being safe online using Microsoft Publisher.

Science

We start the year as biologists. Our topic for the first half term is 'Animals including humans – The circulatory system'. We will cover how the circulatory system works and how things like exercise and drugs affect it.

Design Technology

We will be learning about food technology. Looking at seasonality, cooking and nutrition linked to our science topic.

PSHE

We will begin this term with 'The world of drugs and keeping safe online'. These both link to our computing topic and our science topic for the half term.
