In our history topic this half term we will be researching significant individuals Tim Peake and Helen Sharman. Children can research these individuals and share their findings in our history lessons.

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Learning Journey

English – In English we will be reading 'The way back home' by Oliver Jeffers and 'Man on the moon' by Simon Bartram. During our writing lessons we will be exploring narratives and non-fiction writing in relation to our humanities topic of space and space exploration.

Maths – In maths we will be continuing addition and subtraction (within 10) and revisiting previous learning about number bonds and place value. We will also begin to learn about 2-D and 3-D shape.

Science – In science we will be continuing the topic everyday materials and observing what properties different materials have and how they are suitable for different objects. We are also learning throughout the year about seasonal changes and will design and make a rain gauge.

History – In history we are exploring the key question 'Is there anybody out there?' and exploring significant events such as Apollo 11 (the first human landing on the moon) and focus on the achievement of significant individuals such as Tim Peake and Helen Sharman.

Design Technology- In design technology children will plan, design, and evaluate their own rocket fruit kebabs.

RE/PSHE- In RE children will be exploring how religious groups express their emotions and feelings for nature.

Computing- In computing children will be creating digital drawings.
