Learning Journey

English – In English we will continue reading Stig of The Dump and starting Iron Man by Ted Hughes. During our writing lessons we will be writing a holiday brochure for Skara Brae, a set of instructions on 'How to wash a woolly mammoth and a short narrative about the Christmas star.

Maths – In maths we will be finishing out unit on addition and subtraction and then focussing on multiplication of division of two-digit numbers by a 1-digit number. We will also be looking at different units of measurement.

Science – In science the children will be looking at forces and magnets and planning our own investigations.

History – In history we will be learning about how British society changed during the Iron Age.

Design and technology- In DT we will be creating our own stone/iron age hunting pouch.

Computing- In computing we will be learning about moving animations an creating our own using a selection of frames.

PSHE- In PSHE we will be looking at the importance of respect for others, family trees, mindfulness and exploring the similarities and differences between people.

PE- In PE we will be doing tag rugby and hockey.

Spanish- In Spanish the children will be learning about classroom objects.
