Reminders

Our PE days are Mondays and Fridays, so we ask that children wear their PE kits on these days.

English: We will be reading Viking boy by Tony Bradman. We will also be writing a diary entry perspective of a 'raider' to Britain.

Maths: We will follow the White Rose Scheme of work and cover the following units: Multiplication & Division and Fractions. We will also be working on our arithmetic skills daily.

Science: We will be completing a chemistry unit called materials and their properties. During this unit we will learn about: Comparing everyday materials using their properties, why some materials dissolve in to a liquid form, how to separate solids, liquids and gases and Particular uses of everyday materials.

History: In history, we will be learning about the Vikings and how they conquered Britain. During this unit we will learn about: Stereotypical Vikings, Where Vikings came from and why? How Vikings travelled, Importance of trade to the Vikings and Viking raids.

Computing: In computing, we will focus on moving pictures and audio and how to improve through reshooting and editing

PSHE: This term in PSHE we will be completing the topic healthy relationships learning about: Feelings, love, relationships, families, conflict and respect.

Spanish: This half term we are learning how to recognise, recall and spell the ten masculine/ feminine nouns and transactional language so they can order what they would like to eat and drink in the cafetería.

PE: We will be focusing on tag rugby and hockey.

Design & Technology: In Design & technology, we will be researching and combining different materials to create our very own Viking longboat sail.

Music: In music, we will be working with the Rotherham Music Service and learning how to play the Ukulele.
