## Learning Journey

English - In reading sessions, we will be reading Macbeth. During our writing lessons we will be using The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes, The Origin of Species by Charles Darwin and A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens. The genres we will cover are narrative, persuasive letter, information text and poetry.

Maths - We will be covering a unit about fractions. We will cover how to add, subtract, multiply and divide with fractions, find fractions of an amount and convert fractions.

Science - In science, we are looking at Evolution and Inheritance.
History - We will continue our learning about crime and punishment through the ages. We will focus on Dick Turpin and Highwaymen, Victorian crime and finishing with present day crime.

Geography - We will continue to focus on countries of the world (locating and naming using maps, atlases and globes).

Computing - The focus during computing sessions this term is 3D modelling using 'Tinkercad'.
Art - This will be sculpture inspired by Barbara Hepworth.
PSHE - Our unit is 'The Caring School and Growing Up - Relationships'.
Spanish - The topic this half term is 'La comida - food'.
